Take notice that Williamson Fruit Farms Ltd., Manor Farm, Great Welnetham, Bury St. Edmunds, Suffolk, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from the underground aquifer by means of a borehole at National Grid Reference TL 89205908 at Water Lane, Great Welnetham, Bury St. Edmunds, Suffolk. The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates 68.2 cubic metres per hour, 818 cubic metres per day, 72,700 cubic metres per year, between 1st March and 30th September each year
