PETERBOROUGH CITY COUNCIL

The Council of the City of Peterborough (Off-street Parking Places) Amendment Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Peterborough propose to amend the Council of the City of Peterborough (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1995, to the extent only as shown below. In all other respects the 1995 Order remains in force.

*General**1. Commencement and Citation*

This Order shall come into operation on a date to be decided following the legally required consultation period and may be cited as the City of Peterborough (Off-street Parking Places) Amendment Order 1995.

At 4. Use of Parking Places

delete existing paragraph (2) and insert:

"(2) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place, or any part thereof, for any reason whatsoever, whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary, such as but not exclusively for, the forming up of a parade, the holding of a special event, exclusive use of a particular class of patron (e.g. away/home team football supporters) or on any occasion when there may be a danger to the general public using the parking place.

(3) In the event that the Council shall exercise its powers under sub section (2) hereof, then a motor vehicle waiting in a parking place at the time the suspension takes place shall remain in the parking place unless arrangements for the removal of the motor
