Lower High Street, Tutbury-north-easterly side, between points 72 and 87 metres south-east of its junction with Bridge Street.

No Waiting at any time

High Street, Tutbury—north-west side, from its junction with Duke Street for a distance of 18 metres in a north-easterly direction.

High Street, Tutbury—north-west side, between points 44 and 50 metres north-east of its junction with Duke Street.

High Street, Tutbury—north-west side, from a point 196 metres north-west of its junction with Duke Street at its junction with Lower High Street.

High Street, Tutbury—south-east side, from its junction with Lower High Street for a distance of 15 metres in a south-westerly direction.

High Street, Tutbury---south-east side, from a point 108 metres south-east of its junction with Lower High Street to its junction with Burton Street.

Lower High Street, Tutbury—both sides throughout, except for a length of the north-eastern side between points 72 and 87 metres south-east of its junction with Bridge Street. Bridge Street, Tutbury—north-west side, between points 53 and 127

Bridge Street, Tutbury—north-west side, between points 53 and 127 metres north-east of its junction with Lower High Street. Bridge Street, Tutbury—south-eest side from its junction with Lower High Street for a distance of 127 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Exceptions permit waiting for the purposes of taking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a Disabled Person's Badge, and where necessary in connection with the maintenance of roads and the supply of gas, electricity and water; for emergency service vehicles; for buses waiting at an authorised bus stop, for vehicles being used for flood is defence works or land drainage works; and for so long as is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral.

This Order revokes those parts of the following existing Traffic Regulation Orders insofar as they relate to the above lengths of road:

The Staffordshire County Council (Tutbury) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1949.

The County of Stafford (High Street and Cornmill Lane, Tutbury) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970.

The County of Stafford (High Street A50 and Cornmill Lane, C91 Tutbury) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1980.

This Order is called the Staffordshire County Council (High Street Area, Tutbury) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1995.
