*The Newham (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1995,
Botha Road/Chalk Road/Prince Regent Lane E.13—Road Closure*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Newham, on 22nd August 1995, made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the Newham (Prescribed Route) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 1994.

The notice of making the Experimental Traffic Order appeared in *The London Gazette* (Issue No. 53597) dated 23rd February 1994, under reference 846.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

*The Newham (Prohibition of Stopping on Cab Ranks) (No.)
Traffic Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Newham propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Carlton Road and Leighton Street, Nottingham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1995 (6105)

SANDWELL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Sandwell Borough Council (Cheshire Road etc., Smethwick) (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1995
