NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—SOUTH WESTERN REGION

WATER RESOURCES ACT 1991

The National Rivers Authority hereby gives notice that it intends to apply to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food for confirmation subject to modification of new fisheries byelaws together with amendment to existing Byelaw SW3 made by the National Rivers Authority in pursuance of powers conferred on it by section 210 and paragraph 6 of Schedule 25 of the Water Resources Act 1991, and by all other powers them enabling.

The new byelaws will provide—

Number SW17 prohibition of salmon and migratory trout fishing in the Taw and Torridge District.

(1) In this byelaw, "River Lyn" means the River Lyn and all its tributaries.

(2) No person shall fish for salmon or migratory trout in the Taw and Torridge District by any method other than rod and line and, in the River Lyn, other than by a fixed engine or by rod and line.

Number SW18 return of salmon caught in the Rivers Taw and Torridge during August and September.

During August and September, all female salmon, and all male salmon greater than 70 centimetres (27.5 inches), caught in the Rivers Taw and Torridge must be returned alive to the water without delay.

Number SW19 prohibition of the use of tailers on the Rivers Taw and Torridge.

The use of tailers for removing or assisting with the removal of salmon and migratory trout from the Rivers Taw and Torridge is prohibited at all times.

Proposed amendment to Byelaw SW3—

Byelaw SW3, made by the Authority on 8th May 1991, and confirmed by the Minister on 28th February 1992, shall be amended by:

altering paragraphs (2)(a)(i) and (2)(a)(ii) to read:

(2)(a)(i) one from 1st March to 31st May; or

(2)(a)(ii) two in any period of twenty-four hours or three in any period of seven days from 1st June; or
altering paragraph (3)(a) to read:

(3)(a) salmon in excess of:

(i) one from 1st March to 31st May; or

(ii) two in any period of seven days from 1st June; or

(iii) five in any season;

deleting paragraphs (4) and (5).

During the period of one month from the last publication of this notice:
