

5. The general effect of the Hounslow (Prescribed Route) Order would be to revoke and re-enact in a modified form the Hounslow (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1995 so that the existing one-way working in Tiverton Road, Hounslow is varied to operate in a general south-easterly direction between its junction with Denbigh Road and its junction with Kingsley Road.

6. Under section 90 of the Highways Act 1980, the Council proposes to install a series of road humps in Denbigh Road and Ellington Road, Hounslow. The road humps would cover the full width of the road, 5 metres in length and rise to a height of 75 millimetres on the top.

7. A copy of the proposed Orders, together with a copy of the Orders of 1977 and 1995, of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of plans depicting the lengths of road to which the Orders relate and showing the locations of the proposed road humps, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published in the Planning and Transport Reception Area at the Civic Centre, Lampton Road, Hounslow TW3 4DN.
