#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The London-Fishguard Trunk Road, (A40) (Fishguard Western By-pass) Order 1995*

*The London-Fishguard Trunk Road, (A40) (Fishguard Western By-pass Side Roads) Order 1995*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

1. An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that a road about 1.50 kilometres in length which he proposes to construct at Fishguard in the county of Dyfed shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into force, and
2. An Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, authorising him:
  - a. to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
  - b. to stop up highways;
  - c. to construct new highways;
  - d. to stop up private means of access to premises; and
  - e. to provide new means of access to premises;
 all at Fishguard aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Dyfed as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
