

that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 14th August 1995, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or any provisions contained therein.
