interest for Indexed-Income Bonds, the Index figure issued by the Central Statistical Office in the month of August and applicable to the month of September is 149.1. NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY

Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Norpol Recycling Limited, of Norpol House, Charles Street, Nelson, Lancashire, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from Walverden Water at National Grid Reference SD 86053855 at Nelson, Pendle. The water will be used for cooling purposes.

Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Manor Vinegar Brewery Company Limited, of New Road, Burntwood, Walsall, West Midlands, is applying to the National Rivers Authority to vary licence serial No. 3/28/7/6/G/R to abstract water from the Shenstone Aquifer at National Grid Reference No. SK0580/0874 at Balls Mount, Burntwood.

The variation being applied for is the sinking of a third borehole on the premises, for purposes of maintaining continuity of water supply to processes carried out on site, in the event of failure of one of the two existing borehole pumps. No increase in the quantities abstracted will result from this variation, which is to provide an emergency backup facility only.
