GLOUCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Gloucester (Northgate Street) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Gloucester, exercising the undermentioned powers of the Gloucestershire County Council under arrangements made pursuant to section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 3(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be:

- to prohibit with certain exemptions vehicle movements in Northgate Street, between its junctions with Worcester Street and The Cross, daily between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.;
- to prohibit with certain exemptions the movement of extraneous vehicles in Northgate Street between its junctions with Worcester Street and The Cross, daily between the hours of 5 p.m. and 10 a.m.;
- to prohibit with certain exemptions, the waiting of vehicles at all times in Northgate Street between its junctions with Worcester Street and The Cross; and
- to make Northgate Street between its junctions with The Cross and The Oxboe into a one-way street with exempted vehicles proceeding from Southgate Street, Westgate Street and Eastgate Street allowed to proceed in a northerly direction only.

GLOUCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Gloucester (Northgate Street/London Road) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the Gloucester City Council, exercising the undermentioned powers of the Gloucestershire County Council under arrangements made pursuant to section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be:

- to prohibit driving in that length of Northgate Street from its junction with Black Dog Way/London Road for a distance of 26 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- to make the same length of Northgate Street into a one-way street with exempted vehicles permitted to proceed in a south-westerly direction only.
- to prohibit waiting at any time in that length of the north-west side of Northgate Street from its junction with Worcester Street to its junction with London Road.
- to prohibit waiting at any time in that length of the south-east side of Northgate Street from 10 metres south-west of its junction with Spread Eagle Road to its junction with London Road.
- to restrict waiting to one hour in every two hours in that length of the south-east side of Northgate Street from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Spread Eagle Road for a distance of 20 metres in a south-westerly direction.

(f) to prohibit waiting at any time in that length of the south-east side of Northgate Street from a point 30 metres south-west of its junction with Spread Eagle Road to its junction with Worcester Street.

Exceptions are contained in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden or for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic and the maintenance of any of the lengths of roads or the services therein. An exception is also provided for the vehicle used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

Exceptions to the prohibition of driving only is contained in the Order for public service vehicles, emergency police, fire and ambulance vehicles and mechanical road cleansing vehicles and for the riding of bicycles.
