5. Introduce under secton 63(1) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 a 24 hour Taxi Rank on Gerard Street, north-west side, from a pont 105 metres east of Bryn Street for a distance of 15 metres in a north-easterly direction (3 spaces).

A copy of the Order and the relevant map may be inspected at the New Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on any day from Monday to Friday.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the ground:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or
- (b) that any requirement of the said section 1, or of Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 has not been complied with,

may within 6 weeks of 18th August 1995, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
