Street Trading

Notice is hereby given that the Technical Services Committee, acting under authority delegated to them by the Council, have passed a Resolution under paragraph 2 of Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, in the following terms:

(a) That all streets within the following boundaries which have not hitherto been designed as "prohibited streets" shall henceforth become "prohibited streets":

(i) St. Margarets Road and Devisdale Road, Bowdon.

(ii) Denmark Street, Altrincham.

(iii) Lloyd Street, Moss Lane, Altrincham.

(iv) Waters Reach, Europa Way, Tenax Road, Centenary Way and Trafford Wharf Road (between Waters Reach and Trafford Road) Trafford Park.

(b) That the designation of the length of street known as School Road, Sale, be changed from prohibited street to licensed street.

The date on which this Resolution shall become operative is 1st September 1995.

From this time any persons engaging in street trading in the above-mentioned roads listed in (a)(i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) shall be committing an offence under paragraph 10(1) of Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.
