ST: Fiames's, March tiz. The following Addrefs has been prefented to His Majefty.
An humble Addrefs of the Mayor. Recorder, Aldermen, and Common-Council of the City of Durham, and their Reprefentatives in Parliament. Prefented to His Majelty by the $\mathrm{R}_{\text {Ight }}$ Honourable the Lord Vifcount Townfhend, One of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State ; in the Ablence of the Lord$\mathrm{B}_{1}$ hop of Durham.

Which Addrefs His Majefty woas pleafed to receive very graciouly.

Ratisbon, March 12. Letters of the gth of Jaft Month from Seralio, the chief Town in Bofnia, bring Advice, that the main Army of the Turks is certainly to take the Field in March ; and that the Grand Vizier with 90000 Foot and a Number of Horfe, will march and encamp before Zadar or Zara, a confiderable Sea-Port in Dalmatia belonging to the Venetians, where he is to be joyned by the Flect: He is alfo to have a Train of Two hundred Pieces of Artillery, and Sixty Mortars, moft of the fmaller Sizes; and befides the Officers and Gunners already arrived at Seralio, Two hundred and fifty were expected there the next Week. The Grand Signior defigns to refide, till this Siege fhall be over, at Cupres in Bofnia, where Timber is preparing to build him a Seraglio ; having changed his Refolution of going to Belgrade, to avoid giving Umbrage to the Emperour. Several Velfels of all Sorts are getting ready at Widdin; all the Roads in Bofnia are mended, and the Bridges over the Drin, Bofna, and Verbos, are repaired. The chief Magazines on the Save are to be at Gradiska and Dolbachitz. The Baf, Shaw of Bofnia is ordered to give in an Account of all the Provifions in his Province, and of all the Horfe and Foot he can bring into the Field. Two lyying Camps will be formed on the Frontiers of Croatia. The Advices from Vienna, as to a Rupture with the Turks, are ftll various; tho' repeated Orders have been iffued to all the Imperial Regiments in Hungary, to keep themfelves in a Readinefs to march. Letters of the 15 th of tald Month from Romes ray Copunt Gallas $h$ id received the Emperour'a Leave to make a Tour to Vienna; and was preparing for fetting out on his Journey in 8 or 10 Dayst
Hambourd, March 17. The Duke of Meck. 1enbourg is fet out from Swerin to go to meet the Czar. M. Scbleinitz on the Part of the Czar, and M. Petkum on the Part of the Dulie of Meckienbourg, are idjuuting the Marriage Settlements between that Duke and the Dutchefs Dowager of Courland. The fieavy Cannon from Stralfund being arrived th the Camp before Wifmar, will be placed on Redoubts, which are mazking fof that pur. pofe : The firft Work when the Siege of that

Place in form is begun, will be to cut off the Communication between the Fort of Walfigh and the Town. 'Tis advifed, that there is great Want of Provifions in the faid Town fó that the Inhabitants begin already to fuffr very much. The Czar had fet out from Dantzick for Stargard, but turned back upon receiving Adviet on the Road, that the King of Poland was coming thither to confer with him. His Czarih Majefty has however fent Orders to Copnt Goloffskin his Minifter at Berlin, to repair forthwith to Stargard and wait his Arrival there. Letters from Berlin tell us, that the King of Pruffiay the Imperial Minifiter Count Virmond and other Perfons of Diftinction, will thortly let out for Stargard. The laft Letters from Copenhagen fay the King of Denmark would fet out on the $\mathrm{i}_{4}$ th Inftant for Holtein: And, that the Squadron of Men of War fiting out at Capenhagen, will in a few Days be ready.
Edisburgh, March. 6. Letters from Elick give an Account, that Lieutenant. General Cadogan was atrived there, on' his way hither: That Orders had been fent to Major-General Wightman, for the immediate difarming of the 'Marquifs of Huntley's and Earl of Seaforth's Men, and all the Rebels Clans who are within Reach of the Garrifon of Invernef, and for apprehending their Chiefrains. Directions were alfo fent to Major General Sabine who Commands at Perthy to difarmi Bra-. dalbin's and Drumhond's Men; and fuch of the Duke of Athol's who have been in Rebellion, and to fecure the Gentlemen and Hezetors. A Detachment having been order'd from Aberdeen into the Braes of Mar, the common People who had been in Rebellion brought in their Arms, and fubmitted to Mercy. A confiderable Detachment will forthwith pe feat to Fart-William, in order to the difarming of the Weftern Clans, the Principal of which are thofd of Lochills, Glengary, Clan Renald, and Mackdonald. Which done, the Peace and Tranquiliry of Scotland will be perfectly fecured. We have a Report, that the Marquils of Huntloy and Lord Rollo have furrender'd themifelyek at Invernefs, and that the Eatl of Bradalfin has furrender'd himfelf to Collonel Campbel of Fanab.
