## NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991, SECTION 58  
(ENGLAND AND WALES)

### *Notice of Substantial Road Works (England and Wales)*

Three months advance notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council (Agent Authority to the Highway Agency) intends to carry out substantial road works.

2. The road in which these works will take place is: A41 Aylesbury, Tring Road, carriageway, footway and verges.

3. Work is expected to affect the carriageway, footways and verges from 70 metres west of the junction of Tring Road and Victoria Street, Aylesbury to 50 metres west of the junction with Tring Road and Parton Road, Aylesbury.

4. The works will involve the replacement of all kerb-lines to revised levels, the planning out and resurfacing of the carriageway to an improved profile, the replacement of existing footway surfacing where new kerb levels dictate and the replacement of all road gullies with associated drainage works.

Other works include the refurbishment of the existing street lighting and street furniture, the replacement of all road markings and the application of anti-skid surface treatment at various locations.

5. Work is expected to commence on 6th November 1995, or within one month of this date.

6. Subject to exemptions in the Act and regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 4 above without the consent of the said Highway Authority. Any application for such consent to be addressed to the undersigned.
