Notice of the Issue of a Submarine Pipe-Line Works Authorisation

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Total Oil Marine PLC, whose address is Crawpeel Road, Altens, Aberdeen AB9 2AG and Elf Exploration UK PLC, whose registered office is 30 Buckingham Gate, London SW1 6NN, for the construction of a methanol umbilical between the Dunbar platform and Ellon wellheads.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the umbilical shall only be used to convey methanol.

The pipe-line may be used by the holders and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

Total Oil Marine PLC has been appointed operator of the pipe-line.
