Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Bolton have made an Order under sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, will be as follows:

To extend the 'Pay and Display' system of operation at All Saints Street Surface Level Car Park.

Period of Operation: Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday 12.30 p.m. to 6 p.m. (during co-ordinated Sunday Trading).

Scale of Charges:

Monday to Saturday Area 2, Sunday Areas 1 and 2: 0-1 hour 50p, 1-2 hours £1, 2-3 hours £1.50, Over 3 hours £1.80.

Season Tickets—Area 2: 1 day £1.80, weekly £9, monthly £43.20, half yearly £280.80, annually £561.60.

Excess Charge Waiver and Penalty Charge Waiver if paid within 2 days of issue of notice £10;

Excess Charge Discount Payment and Penalty Charge Discount Payment if paid within 14 days of issue of notice £20;

Excess Charge Penalty and Penalty Charge Payment if paid after 14 days £40.

The Order will be operative from 22nd January 1996.

A copy of the Order, together with relevant plans and statement of the Council's reasons for the Order, may be inspected at The Reception, 1st Floor, Town Hall, Bolton, during normal office hours.

Anybody wishing to question the Order's provisions or validity

may, within 6 weeks from 17th January 1996, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
