ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A1041 Trunk Road (Carlton) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit and Derestriction)

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 82(2), 83(1) and 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A1041 Trunk Road in the district of Selby.

The proposed Order, if made, will remove the 30 m.p.h. speed limit which applies automatically to roads that have had street lighting installed and impose the following limits:

- (i) the national speed limit of 60 m.p.h. on the A1041 Trunk Road from a point 44 metres north of its junction with the centre line of Long Hedge Lane (Carlton) to a point 330 metres south-east of its junction with the centre line of Brigg Lane (Camblesforth);
- (ii) a speed limit of 40 m.p.h. on the said trunk road from a point 23 metres south of its junction with the south side of Hepworths Lane to a point 65 metres south of its junction with Low Street.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A140 Trunk Road (B1134 Tivetshall/Pulham Market Junction, Norfolk) (Derestriction) Order 1996

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A140 Trunk Road at the B1134 Tivetshall/Pulham Market junction in the county of Norfolk.

The effect of the Order is that the A140 Trunk Road from a point 184 metres south of its junction with the B1134 to a point 184 metres north of that junction shall cease to be a restricted road for the

purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The speed limit will revert to the national limit of 60 m.p.h.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any Instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 26th January 1996, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of any provision contained therein.

CONSUMER CREDIT ACT 1974

General Notice No. 1062, Group Licence

I, John Stuart Bridgeman, Director General of Fair Trading, hereby give notice pursuant to section 31(6) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974, that the Group Licence issued to the Institute of Business Counsellors, Europower House, Lower Cookham, Berkshire SL6 9EH ("the Institute") is varied in the following respects:

(1) to remove the limitation on the bodies on behalf of which Members of the Institute may act under the group licence; and

(2) to include all Members of the Institute or persons who under regulations made by the Institute are subject to the obligations and liabilities of a Member of the Institute to carry on the business of

- C. Credit Brokerage; and
- D. Debt Adjusting and Debt Counselling.

The licence is limited to activities carried out in connection with advice given to, or instructions obtained from, and person in relation to debts incurred or to be incurred in connection with a relevant business.

In this notice "relevant business" means:

- (i) the business of a relevant person;
- (ii) the business of a partnership in which a relevant person is a partner;
- (iii) the business of a relevant person's employer; or
- (iv) the business of a body corporate of which a relevant person is a director, secretary or other officer;

"relevant person" means the person to whom advice is given or from whom instructions are obtained, or any relative of his; and "relative" has the same meaning as it does in section 189(1) of the Act.

This licence is valid for a period of five years from 26th January 1996.
