

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Cowleigh Bank and St. Peters Road, Malvern) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that on 1st February 1996, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order which will prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of roads in Malvern:

1. *Cowleigh Bank*, north-west side, from a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western edge of St. Peters Road for a distance of 50 metres in a north-easterly direction; and south-east side, from a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with St. Peters Road to a point 15 metres north-east of that junction;
2. *St. Peters Road*, both sides, from its junction with Cowleigh Bank for a distance of 15 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The Order will come into operation on 14th February 1996.

The Order contains exemptions to allow parking for certain purposes and limited waiting by disabled persons vehicles.

A copy of the Order, relevant map and statement of reasons for making the Order may be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester WR5 2NP, during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 14th February 1996.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNCIL

The Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Ryde, IW) (Width Restriction) Order No. 2 1996

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight Council in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to restrict vehicles over 6' 6" in width from travelling in either direction along Great Preston Road from the junction with Alexandra Road in the junction with High Park Road to include the link road fronting Oakfield Primary School.

The Order is designed to reduce congestion and delay in the said roads and to facilitate the free flow of traffic in the promotion of road safety.

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ash Cum Ridley, Hartley, Longford and Meopham) (Width and Weight Restrictions) Order 1996.

Notice is hereby given that the Kent County Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to prohibit vehicles, the width of which inclusive of any load exceed 6' 6", and goods vehicles the maximum permissible laden weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes on the following roads at Ash Cum Ridley, Hartley, Longfield and Meopham:

1. Lengths of roads in Longfield parish.
 - (a) Hartley Bottom Road from its junction with Main Road (B260) to the parish boundary.
 - (b) Manor Lane from its junction with Main Road (B260) to the parish boundary.
2. Length of roads in Hartley parish.
 - (a) Hartley Bottom Road from the boundary with Longfield parish to the boundary with Ash Cum Ridley parish.
 - (b) Manor Road from the boundary with Longfield parish to its junction with Hartley Bottom Road.
 - (c) Grange Lane, Hartley Hill, Stack Lane, St. Johns Lane, Grange Way, Gresham Avenue, Woodland Avenue, Gorse Wood Road, Johns Close, Gorse Way, Beechlands Close, Briars Way, Manor Drive, Manor Lane, Springcroft, Berrylands and Birlings Hil Shaw for their entire lengths.
3. Lengths of roads in Ash Cum Ridley parish.
 - (a) Ash Road from its northern junction with Chapel Wood Road to its southern junction with Chapel Wood Road.
 - (b) Church Road, North Ash Road, Hartley Bottom Road, Redhill Road, Idleigh Court Road, New Street Road, Rectory Road, Pease Hill, Haven Hill, Pettings Road, Hodsoil Street, Oak Farm Lane, Bunkers Hill, Rosemary Lane, Avelands, Ayelands Lane, Bazes Shaw, Bowes Wood, Caling Croft, Capelands Centre Road, Chapel Wood, Cotlstead, Farm Holt, Foxbury, Knights Croft, Lambardes, Manor Forstal, Meadow Lane, Millfield, Millfield Lane, North Square, Olivers Mill, Over Minnis, Penenden, Punch Croft, The Mead, The Mote, Westfield and West Yoke for their entire lengths.
4. Lengths of roads in Meopham parish.

Shipleigh Hills Road, Ifield Road and Chapmans Hill for their entire lengths.

The proposed prohibition would contain the usual exemptions for access, for public utility and emergency service vehicles.
