Index-linked National Savings Movement of the United Kingdom General Index of Retail Prices

For the purposes of revaluing on repayment index-linked National Savings Certificates (Retirement Issue, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th index-linked Issues) and contributions under Save As You Earn Savings Contracts (Third Issue) and for revising the annual rate of interest for Indexed-income bonds, the index figure issued by the Central Statistical Office in the month of February and applicable to the month of March is 150.2. This figure is based on the revised reference base of 100 adopted in January 1987. In accordance with the relevant prospectuses a notional Index figure of 592.5 has been calculated and will apply to index-linked Savings Certificates and indexed-income bonds purchased in March 1987 or earlier and SAYE contributions which were due for payment and made in February 1987 or earlier.

NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Graham Charles Fletcher representing Elms Vale Laundry Ltd, Cow Lane, Elms Vale, Dover, Kent CT17 9LP having applied to National Rivers Authority, Southern Region to increase the abstraction licence numbered 9/40/4/3GR from the borewell on

site at National Grid Reference TR 3042 41.15 the increased quantity will be recycled and returned to the aquifer by means of a soakaway.

The variation being applied for increases the annual maximum abstraction from 27,276 cubic metres to 32,276 cubic metres and a maximum daily rate from 114 cubic metres to 139 cubic metres.

The discharge to the aquifer is covered by consent numbered P5612/K/CA/94. All relevant checks have been made as to the water levels in the borewell in conjunction with the National Rivers Authority.

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Take notice that R. Roobottom, of Hurst Farm, Chilcote, Swadlincote, Derbyshire is applying to the National Rivers Authority to vary the licence serial numbers 3/28/23/67, 3/28/23/68 and 3/28/23/69 to abstract water from the Haoborough Brook, the River Mease and a tributary of the River Mease at National Grid References SK2948 1270 and SK 2815 1215 and SK 2829 1155 at Hurst Farm, Chilcote. The variations applied for are 3/28/23/69 to change abstraction point to between SK 29481270 and SK 2985 1314; to increase daily rate from 400 to 1,080 cubic metres, to increase annual rate from 2,500 to 5,000 cubic metres. 3/28/23/67 to change abstraction point to SK 2838 1240 and SK 2937 1259; to increase the daily rate from 400 to 1,080 cubic metres, to increase annual rate from 6,800 to 24,000 cubic metres. Also to vary tied clause on all three licences to 1,080 cubic metres per day. The increase in quantities will be subject to flow restrictions.
