### AN EXECUTIVE AGENCY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

*The A1 Trunk Road (Southbound Carriageway) (Oak Grange Farm, north of Catterick) (Prohibition of Right Turn and 'U' Turn).*

The Secretary of State for Transport gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under Section 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A1 Trunk Road in the district of Richmondshire in the county of North Yorkshire.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit all vehicles travelling in the southbound carriageway of the A1 trunk road from turning right or making a 'U' turn, through the gap in the central reservation opposite Oak Grange Farm, Gatherley, north of Catterick.
