TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways ((Tiryberth, Hengoed, Mid Glamorgan) Order 1996

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to authorise the stopping-up of the lengths of highway described in Schedule 1 to this notice.

The stopping-up is authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Rhymney Valley District Council by Rhymney Valley District Council on 9th August 1995, under ref. 5/5/95/0329.

The Order requires the provision of new highway which will be highway maintainable at public expense, for which Mid Glamorgan County Council shall be the Highway Authority.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990; or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may, within 6 weeks of 14th March 1996, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE 1

(All measurements are approximate)

The lengths of highway to be stopped up are at the rear of William Street at Tiryberth, Hengoed, in the county of Mid Glamorgan. They are shown by thin diagonal lines on the annexed plan, are 2.4 metres in width and comprise:

- (i) that length of highway adjacent to properties 1-10, 54 metres in length;
- (ii) that length of highway adjacent to properties 11-18, 43 metres in length;
- (iii) that length of highway adjacent to properties 19-22, 21 metres in length; and
- (iv) that length of highway adjacent to properties 23-30, 43 metres in length

The extension of rear gardens, erection of new boundary walls and construction of a new rear lane. (482)

The A479 Trunk Road (Tretower and Cwmdu, Powys) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. in the lengths of the A479 Glanusk Park (Crickhowell)—Llyswen Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") specified in the Schedule to this notice.
