Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 14 cubic metres per hour, 84 cubic metres per day, 30,660 cubic metres per year. The water will be used for bottling purposes.

Proposed Reduction of Compensation Water from Llyn Celyn

Notice is hereby given that due to an exceptional shortage of rain, the National Rivers Authority ("the Authority") is applying to the Secretary of State for Wales for an Order under sections 73 and 74 of the Water Resources Act 1991, to reduce temporarily the quantity of summer compensation water which is required to be discharged as detailed below:

The compensation water discharge requirements for Llyn Celyn as defined in section 17 of the Liverpool Corporation Act 1957 are: 1st October to 31st March (Winter) 31.8 megalitres per day (7,000,000 gallons) and 1st April to 30th September (Summer) 63.7 megalitres per day (14,000,000 gallons).

The application is to enable the Authority to reduce the level of summer compensation water discharge to 31.8 megalitres per day at times when the river Dee is not being supported by discharges from Llyn Celyn, and whilst the Dee system storage remains below its normal minimum level for the time of year. The Dee system storage is the aggregated storage of Llyn Celyn and Llyn Brenig reservoirs.

If the Order is made, the water retained in Celyn as a result of the proposed compensation water reductions may be subsequently used at the Authority's discretion, to ameliorate any adverse environmental conditions that may arise should the period of dry weather experienced since April 1995 continue into the summer of 1996.

If the Order is made, and during its operation the Authority considers that there is or is likely to be a risk of damage to the aquatic environment as a result of the operation of the Order, the quantity of compensation water discharged will be increased, as necessary up to a maximum of the normal 63.7 megalitres per day.

A map showing the location of Llyn Celyn and the length of watercourse affected, along with a supporting statement, may be inspected, free of charge, at the Authority's Water Resources Office at Trem Tryweryn, Units 11-12 Bala Enterprise Park, Bala LL23 7NL, and at Bala Library, during the normal opening hours of the relevant places, for a period of 7 days from the publication of this notice.

Any objections to the proposed Order must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Wales, (c/o C. S. Clarke) Environment Division, Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF1 3NQ, within 7 days of publication of this notice. It is requested that a copy of any such objections be sent at the same time to the undersigned.
