ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The M4 Motorway Connecting Road Scheme to Second Severn Crossing*

For the purposes of section 17(5) and all other relevant provisions of the above Act, the Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice in

accordance with the Special Roads (Notice of Opening) Regulations 1992, that the 5th June 1996, will be the date on which the special road described in the Schedule to this notice is open for use as a special road.

#### SCHEDULE

That length of the special road (M4) which comprises of dual carriageway and lies between a point commencing 190 metres west of Rockfield Road underbridge in the county of Monmouthshire, and extending 1,880 metres in a generally south-easterly direction to a point at the western limit of Rogiet toll plaza.

*Connections of the Special Road with existing Motorway (to be renumbered M48)*

1. A diversion (620 metres in length), of the existing M4 eastbound carriageway commencing at a point 15 metres east of Rockfield Road underbridge and terminating at a point 280 metres west of Bencroft Lane underbridge.
2. A diversion (1,355 metres in length), of the existing M4 westbound carriageway commencing at a point 190 metres west of Rockfield Road underbridge and terminating at a point 230 metres east of Bencroft Lane underbridge, including a bridge carrying that diversion over Bencroft Lane.

PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

*Notice of the issue of a submarine pipe-line works authorisation*

The Secretary for Trade and Industry, hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Victoria Oilfield Development (UK) Limited, whose registered address is "Tradewinds", 190 Vauxhall Bridge Road, London SW1V 1DX, for the construction of a 152.4 mm pipe-line between MODU Rig 42 and tanker "Hellespont Hope".

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, this pipe-line shall only be used to convey crude oil.

The pipe-line may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.
