MEDICINES ACT 1968

Amendments to the European Pharmacopoeia

The Health Ministers, that is to say the Secretaries of State concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland respectively, and the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, hereby declare under section 65(7) of the Medicines Act 1968 that on and after 1st July 1996, the revised versions of the monographs adopted by the European Pharmacopoeia Commission on 9th November 1995 and referred to in the Schedule hereto, are to have effect for the purposes of section 65 of the said Act in replacement for the monographs contained in the Second Edition of the European Pharmacopoeia, published under the direction of the Council of Europe (Partial Agreement) in accordance with the Convention on the Elaboration of a European Pharmacopoeia.
