The County of Devon (Various Streets, Braunton) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that, Devon County Council propose to make the above-named Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a one-hour limited waiting restriction between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. daily (return prohibited within one hour) in the lengths of Exeter Road currently limited to a thirty minutes waiting restriction thereby allowing an increasing in waiting time.

The proposed Order will contain the usual exemptions relating to the picking-up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, disabled person's vehicles, the maintenance of the road and telecommunications apparatus and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

The County of Devon (Various Streets, Bideford) (Control of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that, on 30th May 1996, Devon County Council made the above-named Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is:

- (a) to prohibit vehicles from waiting at all times in specified lengths of Grenville Street; High Street and Market Place;
- (b) to prohibit vehicles from waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive, in specified lengths of Grenville Street, High Street and Market Place;
- (c) to limit the length of time vehicles may wait to 1 hour (no return within 1 hour) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive, in specified lengths of Grenville Street and Market Place;
- (d) to limit the length of time vehicles may wait to 30 minutes (no return within 30 minutes) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive, in specified lengths of High Street;
- (e) to remove the existing restriction on loading and unloading in a specified length of High Street; and
- (f) to remove the existing limited waiting restriction on the south side of Lower Gunstone.

The Order contains the usual exemptions relating to the picking-up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods (where appropriate), disabled persons vehicles, the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on Monday, 10th June 1996, together with a plan illustrating the lengths of roads concerned may be examined during normal office hours, Monday to Friday at either Room 402, Civic Centre, Barnstaple, or Torridge District Council Offices, Riverbank House, Bideford.

- (a) to impose one-way traffic in:
 - (i) Silver Street requiring all vehicles to travel from Meddon Street to Market Place;
 - (ii) High Street vehicles to travel up-hill;
 - (iii) Buttgarden Street from Market Place towards Lower Meddon Street;
 - (iv) Market Place, west, north and east side, in a clock-wise direction only.
 - (v) Lower Meddon Street from New Road to a point 38 metres east of the Torridge Hill/Meddon Street junction;
- (b) to reverse the direction of traffic flow in Allhalland Street;
- (c) to prohibit vehicles from proceeding in specified lengths of Market Place (south side);
- (d) to remove the one-way restriction on the southern side of Market Place; and
- (e) to introduce a box junction in Bridge Street at the Allhalland Street/Nunnery Walk junction.

*The County of Devon (Various Streets, Bideford) (Control of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 2) Order 1996**Proposed alterations to waiting restriction in Buttgarden Street*

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make the above-named Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to prohibit vehicles from waiting at all times in certain lengths of Buttgarden Street;
- (b) to prohibit vehicles from waiting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in other lengths of Buttgarden Street;
- (c) to prohibit vehicles from waiting for more than 2 hours (no return within 2 hours) between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in the remaining lengths of Buttgarden Street; and
