The European Economic Interest Grouping Regulations 1989

Under section 139(6) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that certain goods, namely:

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Regulation 15(1)(a) of the European Economic Interest Grouping Regulations 1989, of amendments in the particulars of the contract for the formation of the undermentioned European Economic Interest Grouping:

Two Type FS60 Gyroscopes

which have been seized as liable to forfeiture by virtue of the Export of Goods (Control) Orders 1985 to 1992, made pursuant to the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939 and are liable to forfeiture under section 3(1) of the same Act and section 68 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979.

If you claim that the goods are not liable to forfeiture, you must within one month of the date of this notice of seizure give written notice of your claim in accordance with paragraph 3 of Schedule 3 to the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979. If you are outside the United Kingdom, you must specify the name and address of a solicitor in the United Kingdom who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf. If you make such a claim within that time, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation of the goods.

These are civil proceedings which you should attend to explain to the court why you feel that the goods should not be condemned as forfeit. You may be legally represented at these proceedings if you wish. It will be a matter for the Court to decide whether or not the goods should be condemned and forfeiture confirmed.

If no such claim is made, the goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeit.
