The Stopping-up of Highways (Byway Number 2, Pwllheli, Gwynedd) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has appointed Sir Peter Bairsto, M.B.E., C.B., A.F.C., D.L., C.B.I.M., to attend at the Council Chambers, Gwynedd Council, Penlan Street, Pwllheli, from 10 a.m. on Tuesday, 2nd July 1996, to hold a public local inquiry to hear the objections lodged against the Secretary of State's proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The effect of this proposed Order would be to stop-up the length of highway described in the Schedule to this notice to enable a security fence to be erected in accordance with planning permission granted on appeal to Firmhelm Limited, on 9th December 1993, in accordance with the terms of the planning application No. 2/25/207D, dated 30th March 1993.

SCHEDULE

The length of highway to be stopped-up is at the Firmhelm Boatyard, The Harbour, Pwllheli, in the county of Gwynedd, and is that length of highway known as Byway Number 2, which extends from a point 23 metres south of the most southerly point of the lifeboat house in a north-easterly direction for a distance of (481) 67 metres.
