TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Hampshire) (No. 12) Order 1996", authorising the stopping up of highway land adjacent to 96 Locksway Road, Milton, Portsmouth in the county of Hampshire.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the power of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks

of 18th June 1996, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of three areas of highway at Wolston Close and an area of highway at Holme Lane, Holmewood, Bradford.

If the Order is made, the stopping up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to the Senior Partner of the Design and Construction Services Division, by the Head of Transportation and Planning of Bradford Metropolitan Council, on 15th March 1995, under Ref. 95/00392/FUL.
