(C1193 Preston-on-Wye)

(Temporary Closure) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make an Order the effect of which is to close the C1193 Preston-on-Wye from its junction with the C1191 for approximately 350 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The Order is being made to facilitate drainage works.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit access to any land or premises having a frontage to the highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to allow the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternative route for those affected by the proposal is via the C1193—B4352—C1198—C1191—C1193.

The proposed Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is expected that the Order will only be operative for 4 weeks.

(C2109 Bacton)

(Temporary Closure) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make an Order the effect of which is to close the C2109, Bacton from its junction with the UC74209 for approximately 400 metres in an easterly direction.

The Order is being made to facilitate works on or near the highway.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit access to any land or premises having a frontage to the highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to allow the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternative route for those affected by the proposal is via the UC4209—C1212—B4347—C1209.

The proposed Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is expected that the Order will only be operative for 4 weeks.

(UC72416 Cotts Lane, Lugwardine)

(Temporary Closure) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make an Order the effect of which is to close the UC72416 Cotts Lane, Lugwardine from a point approximately 150 metres south of the A4103 for approximately 300 metres in a southerly direction.

The Order is being made to facilitate drainage/haunching works.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit access to any land or premises having a frontage to the highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to allow the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternative route for those affected by the proposal is via the A438—C1144 Cotts Lane—A4103.

The proposed Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is expected that the Order will only be operative for 3 weeks.

(B4347 Vowchurch)

(Temporary Closure) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council have made an Order the effect of which is to close the B4347 Vowchurch from a point approximately 800 metres south of its junction with the B4348 for a distance of approximately 200 metres in an easterly direction.

The Order has been made to facilitate works on or near the highway.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit access to any land or premises having a frontage to the highway affected, where there is no other form of access; and to allow the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternative route for those affected by the Order is via B4347—C1224—C1223—C1222—B4348.

The Order will come into force on 24th June 1996 and may remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months. However, it is expected that it will only be operative for 3 weeks.

(A4137 Marstow and Whitchurch)

(Temporary Closure) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council have made an Order the effect of which is to close the A4137 from its junction with the A40 to a point approximately 20 metres north of Marstow Bridge.

The Order has been made to facilitate works on or near the highway.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit access to any land or premises having a frontage to the highway affected, where there is no other form of access; and to allow the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternative route for those affected by the Order is via the A40—Wilton—A49—B4521—St. Owens Cross—A4137.

The Order will come into force on 24th June 1996 and may remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months. However, it is expected that it will only be operative for 4 weeks.

(The Hedgerows, Lickey End) (Prohibition of Waiting)

Order 1996

On 13th June 1996, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order which will prohibit waiting at any time on both sides of The Hedgerows, Lickey End, from its junction with B4096 Alcester Road for its entire length. The Order will come into operation on 24th June 1996.

The Order contains exemptions to allow parking for certain purposes and limited waiting by disabled persons vehicles.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 25th July 1996.

(St. Peters Drive, Worcester) (Bus Stop) (Clearway) (No. 4)

Order 1996

On 13th June 1996, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order which will prohibit waiting between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., at any marked bus stops on the entire length of St. Peters Drive, Worcester. The Order will come into operation on 24th June 1996.

The Order contains exemptions to allow parking for certain purposes.

The Leicestershire County Council (Various Roads, Hinckley) (De-restriction and Imposition of 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

- (1) that the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this notice will cease to be subject to a 30 m.p.h. speed limit imposed by virtue of street lighting; and
- (2) that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on that length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
