

(ii) prohibit the movement of vehicular traffic between Westbrooke Road the section of South Gipsy Road, south of Westbrooke Road, and the section of South Gipsy Road, north of Westbrooke Road/Palmeira Road. (There would be a north-west to south-east diagonal closure across the junction of South Gipsy Road, Westbrooke Road and Palmeira Road).

3. The general effect of the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. ) Traffic Order 1996 would be to amend the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1991 so as to introduce "At any time" restrictions in parts of the roads listed in Schedule 1 to this Order and at the junctions listed in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

4. The general effect of the Bexley (Miscellaneous Parking Places) Traffic Order 1996 would be to:

- (i) revoke the Bexley (Miscellaneous Free Parking Places) Order 1987 and re-enact the parking places in that Order) and
- (ii) introduce new parking places, where vehicles are permitted to wait for a limited period between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday, in Park View Road (maximum one hour) and Wrotham Road (maximum two hours).

5. The prohibitions referred to in 2 and 3 above would not apply:
- (a) to vehicles being used for ambulance fire brigade or police purposes in certain circumstances or cycles ; or
  - (b) in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
  - (c) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.
