ELECTRICITY ACT 1989

Notice under section 11(2) of the Electricity Act 1989

The Director General of Electricity Supply (hereinafter referred to as "the Director") pursuant to section 11(2) of the Electricity Act 1989 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") hereby gives notice as follows:

1. He proposes to modify the conditions of the public electricity supply licences granted to ScottishPower plc and Scottish Hydro-Electric plc under section 6(1)(c) of the Act by amending in respect of each licence holder Condition 19 of Part V (provision of information to the Director) and Schedule 6 (public electricity supply charge restriction conditions).
2. He proposes to make the modifications because the licence holders have entered into a Supplemental Agreement to the Nuclear Energy Agreement with Scottish Nuclear Limited for the purchase of nuclear generated electricity.
3. In summary, the effect of the modifications is:
 - (a) to deduct from the costs of generation which the licence holders may recover from franchise customers an amount equal to the premium which, but for the Supplemental Agreement, would have been paid by the licence holders for nuclear generated electricity;
 - (b) to require the licence holders to provide the Director with information relating to the calculation of the nuclear premium; and
 - (c) to remove the requirement on the licence holders to provide the Director with details of the annual demand to premises within their authorised supply areas.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BARNESLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley (Goldthorpe, Thurnscoe and Bolton-on-Deerne) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 1987 (Amendment No. 5) Order 1996.

Notice is hereby given that on 24th June 1996 the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council made an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 1st July 1996 will be to introduce a traffic management scheme at Goldthorpe Town Centre which will:

- (i) amend the existing prohibition of waiting at any time and prohibition of waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday on parts of Barnsley Road, Doncaster Road and Whitworth Street, Goldthorpe;
- (ii) introduce Disabled Persons Vehicles Parking Areas on parts of Barnsley Road, Doncaster Road and Whitworth Street;
- (iii) introduce Unrestricted Parking Places and Parking Places limited to a maximum period of waiting of 1 hour, return prohibited in 3 hours on parts of Barnsley Road and Doncaster Road.

Waiting will be permitted for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and services therein, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets. The usual exceptions for disabled persons' vehicles are also included in the Order.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted road may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council, Town Hall, Barnsley and (ii) the Branch Library, Barnsley Road, Goldthorpe.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made
