The Buckinghamshire County Council (High Wycombe) (Designated Parking Places) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order which would have the effect of designating parking places in High Wycombe and applying restrictions and charges for the use of those parking places.

This notice describes the nature and general effect of the proposed Order. Specific details can be ascertained by inspecting the documentation in relation to this scheme. A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the reasons for the Order and a map showing the designated lengths of road and the boundaries of the parking Zones A, B and C may be inspected during normal office hours at the Municipal Offices, High Wycombe District Council, Queen Victoria Road, High Wycombe; during opening hours at High Wycombe Library, Queen Victoria Road, High Wycombe and during normal office hours at Buckinghamshire County Council Offices, County Hall, Aylesbury, until 15th August 1996.

Streets in which parking places would be designated:

Aveling Road, Baker Street, Bellfield Road, Benjamin Road, Bridge Street, Bridle Gate, Brook Street, Castle Street, Cedar Terrace, Conegra Road, Corn Market, Denmark Street, Desborough Avenue, Desborough Road, Desborough Street, Dovecot Road, Duke Street, Easton Street, Easton Terrace, East Richardson Street, Frogmoor, George Street, Green Street, The Greenway, Gordon Road, Hamilton Road, Hampden Road, Harlow Road, High Street, Jubilee Road, Kitchener Road, London Road, Oakridge Road, Paul's Row, Peterborough Avenue, Plumer Road, Priory Avenue, Priory Road, Queen Alexandra Road, Queens Road, Queen Street, Rectory Avenue, Roberts Road, Rutland Street, Saffron Road, Saftesbury Street, Short Street, Slater Street, Station Road, Stuart Road, Suffield Road, Temple End, Upper Green Street, Victoria Street, Wendover Street, West End Road, West End Street, Westbourne Street and West Richardson Street.

The following time limits for waiting and loading would apply to certain parking spaces:

20 minutes waiting only; unlimited waiting for Zone A permit holders; 30 minutes pay and display spaces; unlimited waiting for Zone A and C permit holders; 2 hours pay and display spaces; 20 minutes waiting for Zone A permit holders; unlimited waiting for Zone B permit holders; unlimited waiting for Zone C Permit holders; 1 hour pay and display spaces; 10 minutes waiting only; solo motorcycles only; 10 minutes waiting or 20 minutes loading; 10 minutes waiting and 20 minutes loading. Some of the spaces would have more than one kind of use permitted and some of the above would be subject to a restriction that no vehicle may return within one hour of leaving.

The following hours of operation of restrictions would apply to certain parking spaces:

9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 12 noon to 4 p.m. on Sundays; Monday to Saturday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Monday to Friday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Monday to Friday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.; Monday to Friday 7 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.

The following charges would apply to certain parking spaces:

20 pence for 15 minutes and pro rata up to 2 hours maximum; the penalty charge payable for any breach of the restrictions imposed by this Order would be £40 subject to a reduction if paid within 14 days; the charge for using a designated parking place for other purposes would be not more than £10 on application and £2.75 daily.

This Order would prohibit waiting by heavy goods vehicles and buses at any time in designated parking places and would affect all classes of vehicles.

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order which would provide for the introduction of residents parking permits in High Wycombe. The permits would cover three Zones; A in the town centre and B and C in the areas surrounding the town centre. A list of streets comprising Zones A, B and C can be found at the end of this notice.

The charges for residents parking permits would be: £5 for three months, £10 for six months and £20 annually and for visitors 20 pence daily. There would also be special arrangements for doctors on call, nurses and health workers, works vehicles and some others. Temporary permits would also be obtainable.
