#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

##### *Proposed Stopping-up of a Highway at Rochdale*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Burr Design Associates on behalf of Selecta International Limited, he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of a length of Stuart Street and an unnamed footpath running from the easterly end of Stuart Street eastwards to its intersection with Rough Hey Walk, at Rochdale.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Selecta International Limited by Rochdale Metropolitan Borough Council on 16th April 1996, under reference D32681.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during the 28 days commencing on 17th July 1996, at the Town Hall, Rochdale, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Department of Transport (quoting reference GO/TNW 5084/35/1/31), at the address stated below.

#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

##### *The Derbyshire County Council (London Road, Derby Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1995*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modifications the Derbyshire County Council (London Road, Derby Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1995, which was made by Derbyshire County Council under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council:

- (c) to construct new highways, and
