

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Stopping-up of Parts of Alms Place (off Church Street) Heavitree, Exeter, Devon

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Devon) (No. SW 6) Order 1996" authorising the stopping-up of parts of Alms Place (off Church Street), Heavitree, Exeter, Devon, to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission referred to in that Schedule, and requiring the provision of a new highway and an improvement of Alma Place.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or that any requirement of that Act, or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 26th September 1996, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A35 Trunk Road (Chideock) (30 and 40 miles per hour Speed Limits) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A35 Trunk Road in the District of West Dorset in the county of Dorset.

The effect of the Order would be:

- (1) To impose a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on the A35 at Chideock, between a point 630 metres east of its junction with Seatown Road and a point 810 metres east of that junction, a total distance of approximately 180 metres. This would be an extension eastwards of the 30 m.p.h. speed limit which is currently in force through Chideock.
- (2) To impose 40 m.p.h. speed limits on the following lengths of the A35 at Chideock:
 - (a) between a point 810 metres east of its junction with Seatown Road and a point 1140 metres east of that junction, a total distance of 330 metres; and
 - (b) between a point 200 metres west of its junction with Seatown Road and a point 750 metres west of that junction, a total distance of 550 metres.

This would replace the 60 m.p.h. speed limit which is currently in force on these lengths of road.

A copy of the draft Order, of a plan illustrating the proposal and of a statement explaining why the Secretary of State proposes to make the Order may be inspected during office hours at the offices of Dorset County Council, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester, at those of West Dorset District Council, Mountfield, Rax Lane, Bridport, and during opening hours at Chideock Post Office, Chideock.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The A303 Trunk Road (Ilminster Bypass Improvement) (Side Roads) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the improvement to the A303 Trunk Road to be constructed by him between Southfields Roundabout and Hayes End Roundabout in the county of Somerset, which will authorise him to:

- (1) (a) improve highways,
- (b) stop up highways,
- (c) construct new highways,
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the improved trunk road mentioned above.

- (2) Provide for the transfer of each new highway to be constructed to Somerset County Council as highway authority from the date on which he notifies them that the new trunk road has been completed and is open for traffic.

The A43 Trunk Road (M40/Ardley Interchange to B4031 Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order (No. SW 12) 199
