The Shellfish and Specified Fish (Third Country Imports) Order 1992 (S.I. 1992 No. 3301)

General Licence to Import Eggs of Triops Longicauddatus and Artemia Species

1. In pursuance of section 10 of the Animal Health Act 1981, and Article 3 of the Shellfish and Specified Fish (Third Country Imports) Order 1992, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales hereby authorise the importation into Great Britain of eggs of *Triops* Longicauddatus (tadpole shrimp) and Artemia species (brine shrimp) from all third countries.

2. This licence is not a dispensation from any prohibition other than that laid down in Article 3(1) of the Shellfish and Specified Fish (Third Country Imports) Order 1992.

3. This licence is valid with effect from 11th October 1996, until further notice but may be revoked, varied or suspended at any time by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales.
