*The Borough Council of Gateshead (Shields Road (A185) Pelaw (Bus Lane) Order 1996*

Notice is hereby given that on 15th October 1996, the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

*Gosport Borough Council Traffic Regulation Order*

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council as agents for the Hampshire County Council propose to make the following Orders under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

*Borough of Gosport (Western Way/Solent Way) (Prohibition of Waiting at any Time) (No. 8) Order 1996*

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the north-east side of Western Way for a short distance either side of its junction with Solent Way; on the south-west side of Western Way between Nos. 30 and 34, and for a short distance on both sides of Solent Way in a north-easterly direction from its junction with Western Way.

*Borough of Gosport (Clayhall Road/Haslar Road/Mabey Close) (Prohibition of Waiting at any Time) (No. 13) Order 1996*

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the north side of Clayhall Road from a point a short distance west of its junction with Mabey Close to a point adjacent to No. 97; on both sides of Clayhall Road in a south-easterly direction from its junction with Haslar Road to a point adjacent to No. 150; on both sides of Mabey Close for a short distance in a northerly direction from its junction with Clayhall Road and on the south-east side of Haslar Road for a short distance in a north-easterly direction from its junction with Clayhall Road.

#### HALTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Halton Borough Council (Derby Road, Widnes) (Revocation and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1996*

Notice is hereby given that Halton Borough Council, as agents for Cheshire County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to prohibit waiting in Derby Road as specified in the Schedule below.

The Order will contain exemptions from the prohibition of waiting for the purpose of loading, boarding and alighting, building operations, removal or obstructions to traffic, road works, maintenance of essential services, delivery and direction of postal packages for emergency vehicles, by disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme and passenger service vehicles.

The Order will revoke:

- (iii) the Halton Borough Council (Parking Places and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970 in so far as it relates to Derby Road.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the length of road to which it relates together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Municipal Building, Kingsway, Widnes, at the Information Centre, Church Street, Runcorn, and at the Reception, Runcorn Town Hall, Heath Road, during normal office hours.

*Derby Road, north side from a point 50 metres east of its junction with Beaconsfield Road for a distance of 50 metres in an easterly direction. No waiting at any time;*

*north side from Birchfield Road to a point 50 metres east of its junction with Beaconsfield Road. No waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday (inclusive);*

*north side from a point 100 metres east of Beaconsfield Road to a point 146 metres east of that junction. Limited waiting for 20 minutes in any 1 hour—8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday (inclusive);*

*north side from a point 13.5 metres from its junction with Peelhouse Lane to a point 146 metres east of its junction with Beaconsfield Road. No waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday (inclusive);*

*south side from a point 37 metres west of its junction with Peelhouse Lane to a point 60 metres west of its junction with Durham Road. No waiting at any time;*

*south side from a point 13.5 metres west of the junction with Peelhouse Lane to a point 37 metres west of that junction. Limited waiting 20 minutes in any hour—8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday;*

*south side from a point 60 metres west of its junction with Durham Road to its junction with Cornwall Street. No waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday (inclusive);*

*both sides from the junction with Peelhouse Lane for a distance of 13.5 metres in a westerly direction. No waiting at any time.*

*Hartlepool Borough Council (Southburn Terrace) (Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1996*
