

Any person may object to the making of the proposed Order within the period of 28 days commencing on 17th December 1996, by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, quoting the above reference, at the office of The Director, Environment and Transport, Government Office for the North-East, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle upon Tyne NE1 4TD.
