HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 116 AND 12TH SCHEDULE

Stopping-up/Diversion of Public Footpath MR215, Stansted

Notice is hereby given that the Education Department of Kent County Council has applied to me for an Order to extinguish Public Footpath MR215 at Stansted, on the grounds that it is unnecessary, and that closure of the path will lead to increased safety and security of the school, its pupils and staff.

It is my intention, therefore, to make an application to the Magistrates, sitting at the Courthouse, Police Station Road, West Malling, to stop up all highway rights on the entire length of this footpath. An initial hearing has been set for 10 a.m., on Wednesday, 29th January 1997. A simultaneous application to divert the path will also be made, that such would be more commodious. The effect of this diversion proposal would be to divert the entire length of Footpath MR215 to a new alignment, commencing at its existing junction with Plaxdale Green Road, then running generally
