HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

DEDDF PRIFFYRDD 1980

The Chester-Holyhead Trunk Road (A55) (Bryngwran to Holyhead Side Roads) (Supplementary) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the new trunk road to be constructed by him from Bryngwran to Holyhead, in the Isle of Anglesey, to make, under sections 12, 14, 125 and 268 of the Highways Act 1980, an Order which will:

- a. authorise him:
 - i. to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
 - ii. to stop up highways;
 - iii. to construct new highways;
 - iv. to stop up private means of access to premises; and
 - v. to provide new means of access to premises,

all on, or in the vicinity of the route of the above-mentioned new trunk road, and

- b. provide for the transfer of the said new highways to the Isle of Anglesey County Council, as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
