SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL

(Taxi Stands, Hanham, Borough of Kingswood) (Variation of Waiting Restrictions) Order 1997

Notice is hereby given that on 7th January 1997, South Gloucestershire Council made an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which is to vary further the County Council of Avon (Various Roads, Hanham, District of Kingswood) (General Traffic Regulation) Order 1987 so as to prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time, subject to specified exemptions, in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The intention to make this Order was originally advertised under the heading County Council of Avon (Taxi Stands, Downend and Hanham, Borough of Kingswood) (Variation of Waiting Restrictions) Order 199 , however, the amendments to the taxi stands in Downend requiring an amendment to the waiting restrictions is not to be proceeded with.

The Order will come into operation on 27th January 1997, and a copy thereof together with a map, a copy of the Order to be varied and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order may be inspected at the undermentioned offices during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks after the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
