WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1967

Authority given under Section 7

Whereas:

- A. The importation of CB apparatus is restricted by the Wireless Telegraphy (Citizens' Band and Amateur Apparatus) (Various Provisions) Order 1988 (S.I. 1988/1215), as amended by the Wireless Telegraphy (Citizens' Band and Amateur Apparatus) (Various Provisions) (Amendment) Order 1995 (S.I. 1995/2588) (as so amended, "the Order").
- B. The Secretary of State is satisfied as required by section 7(9) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967 ("the 1967 Act") that this Authority and the terms and conditions attached to it are compatible with the international obligations of the United Kingdom.

Now, therefore:

1. The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the 1967 Act, gives authority to any person to take any action which would otherwise be restricted by article 3 of the Order in respect of CB apparatus operating in the frequency bands 26.960-27.410 MHz and 27.59625-27.99625 MHz which complies with Department of Trade and Industry Performance Specification MPT 1382 published in March 1995 and revised and reprinted in January 1997.
