Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Take notice that The Wales Family Partnership, of Eastgate House, Marham, Kings Lynn, Norfolk, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary a licence serial number 7/34/11/G/295, to abstract water from chalk underground strata at National Grid Reference TG 11911515, at Morton-on-the-Hill, Weston Longville, in the county of Norfolk.

The variation being applied for is to increase the quantities abstracted from the above borehole, and give up the total amount of water abstracted direct from the River Wensum. The quantities applied for are 1,418 cubic metres per day, 100,500 cubic metres per year, between 1st March and 30th September each year. The water will be used for spray irrigation.

There will be no overall increase in the quantities already licensed, only a change from where the water is abstracted.

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Take notice that The Wales Family Partnership, of Eastgate House, Marham, Kings Lynn, Norfolk, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary a licence serial number 6/33/58/51/11, to abstract water from the River Nar, at National Grid Reference TF 724120, at Marham, Kings Lynn, in the county of Norfolk.

The variations being applied for are to increase the area of land on which the water will be used, and to increase the quantities of water abstracted to 90.94 cubic metres per hour, 1,527.4 cubic metres per day and 34,530 cubic metres per year, between 1st April and 31st October each year. The water will be used for spray irrigation.

The increase in quantities will be compensated by giving up totally an equal amount of water abstracted under licence 6/33/58/35/6, from the Ketlam Drain and the County Drain.
