Notice of Application for Consent in pursuance of Schedule 10

Haggerston Castle Caravan Park, Berwick-upon-Tweed, Northumberland

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991 (as amended by the Environment Act 1995) that an application (reference number 210/1132) has been made to the Environment Agency.

The Bourne Leisure Group have applied for consent to discharge 500 cubic metres per day of treated sewage to the North Low from a new sewage treatment works at Haggerston Castle Caravan Park, Berwick-upon-Tweed, Northumberland. The sewage will receive tertiary treatment and discharge via a new outfall terminating at National Grid Reference NU05804390. The discharge from the existing sewage treatment plant to the South Low will continue to be made.
