CHELTENHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Cheltenham (Various Roads) (20 m.p.h. speed limit) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd January 1997, Cheltenham Borough Council in accordance with arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with Gloucestershire County Council the highway authority and in pursuance of the powers of the said County Council under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and in exercise of all other powers it enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, made an Order the effect of which will be to impose a speed limit of 20 m.p.h. on the entire lengths of the following roads:

- (a) St Lukes Road
- (b) St Lukes Place
- (c) Mitre Street (d) Sandford Street
- (u) Sanatora Succe

The Order will come into effect on 30th January 1997, and will be effective for a maximum period of 18 months but it is the council's intention in due course to apply to the Secretary of State for Transport for consent to make a further Order giving permanent effect to these restrictions.
