TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 249 of the above Act entitled "The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (Tyne and Wear) (No. 8) Order 1997", authorising the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on the lengths of Lowdham Avenue, Ripley Avenue and West Percy Road, North Shields, Tyne and Wear.

The Order contains provisions for permitting the use of those lengths of highway by pedal cycles and by vehicles being used:

- (a) for Police, Ambulance or Fire Brigade purposes;
- (b) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said lengths of highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984; and
- (c) in the service of the Local Authority in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or that any requirement of Act, or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 11th March 1997, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or of any provision contained therein.
