NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND

Pursuant to section 139(6) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 thereto, the Commissioners hereby give notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts, certain goods namely: 376 cases of assorted beer and wine, listed on Appendix A were detained from Hightons Warehouse, Fircroft Road, Edenbridge, Kent, on 28th November 1996, and are now alleged to be liable to forfeiture by force of the following provisions, namely:

Regulation 16 of the Excise Goods (Holding, Movement, Warehousing and REDS) Regulations 1992; and section 49(1) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979; section 100(2)(e) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 and section 141(1) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in writing in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Schedule 3 to the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979.

If you do not give notice of a claim within the said period of one month or, if any requirement of the above mentioned paragraph 4 is not complied with, the goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeit.

If you do give notice of claim in the proper form, the Commissioners will take legal proceedings for the condemnation of the said goods.
