#### **WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1949**

Notice of Variation of Citizens' Band Radio Licence

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice, pursuant to section 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949, to holders of the Citizens' Band Radio Licence ("the Licence") that, from 16th June 1997, each Licence shall be varied as follows:

- 1. In this notice "the Booklet" means the Terms, Provisions and Limitations Booklet, the terms of which form part of the
- As and from the date hereof, the Licence shall be read and construed as if:
  - (1) in clause 1(a) of the Booklet, the words "or MPT 1321 or MPT 13333" were deleted and replaced by ", MPT 1321, MPT 1333 or MPT 1382";
  - (2) clause 5 of the Booklet were renumbered as sub-clause 5(1) and the words "whom the Licensee has reasonable grounds to

believe is not a disqualified person," were inserted after "any person";

- (3) a new sub-clause were inserted after sub-clause 5(1):
- "5(2) In this clause 5, a "disqualified person" means any person:
  - (a) whose United Kingdom Citizens' Band Radio Licence is currently revoked;
  - (b) whose last application for a Citizens' Band Radio Licence was refused by the Secretary of State due to revocation action; or
  - (c) who, in the last six months, has been convicted of an offence under the wireless telegraphy legislation in the UK.";
- (4) in sub-clause 7(4) of the Booklet, the words "The Secretary of State reserves the right to publish the name of the Licensee if the Licence is revoked." were inserted after "revocation of the Licence.";
- (5) in clause 10 of the Booklet, the words "unless the individual is a disqualified person as defined in sub-clause 5(2) of this Terms, Provisions and Limitations" were inserted after "CEPT Citizens' Band Radio users"; and
- (6) in Note 2 to the Booklet, words "sub-clause 5(b)" were deleted and replaced by "clause 5".

#### PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPELINES ACTS 1975

Notice of the issue of a Submarine Pipe-line Works Authorisation

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Shell U.K. Limited, whose address is Shell Mex House, Strand, London WC2R 0DX, for the use of a 152-4 millimetre pipe-line between the Borgny Dolphin drilling rig and the M/V Crystal Sea at a subsea well location at Curlew 'B'.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the 152.4 mm pipe-line shall only be used to convey crude oil.

The pipe-line may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

Halliburton Manufacturing and Services Limited (HMSL) has been appointed operator of the pipe-line.
