ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS

The Tower Hamlets (Bus Lane) (No. 2) Experimental Traffic Order 1997

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets on 30th June 1997, made the above-mentioned Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of, and Part 1 of Schedule 5, of the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) provide a bus lane in Bethnal Green Road; eastbound from a point 3.5 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Wear Place to a point 11.5 metres west of the western kerb-line of Hollybush Gardens to operate weekdays from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.;
- (b) further amend the Tower Hamlets (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976, so that the following restrictions will apply in Bethnal Green Road;
 - (i) northern kerb-line, from the eastern kerb-line of Wear Place to the western kerb-line of Cambridge Heath Road, waiting restriction Monday to Friday between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m., and Saturday between 8 a.m. and 1.30 p.m.
 - (ii) northern kerb-line, from the eastern kerb-line of Wear Place, to the western kerb-line of Hollybush Gardens, loading restriction Monday to Friday between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m.
 - (iii) northern kerb-line, from the western kerb-line of Hollybush Gardens, to the western kerb-line of Cambridge Heath Road, loading restriction Monday to Friday between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m., and Saturday between 8 a.m. to 1.30 p.m.
 - (iv) northern kerb-line, meter parking places outside numbers 431-437 and 455-463 will operate Monday to Friday between 8.30 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- (c) further amend the Tower Hamlets (Parking Places) (No. 5) Order 1997, so that 4 new market trader parking places are operational on the south side of Bethnal Green Road outside property numbers 272-290, 316-326, 344-356 and 426-432, totalling 16 parking spaces.
- (d) prohibit;
 - (i) all vehicles from turning right from Wilmot Street into Bethnal Green Road;
 - (ii) all vehicles from proceeding in Rushmead other than in a generally north bound direction;
 - (iii) all vehicles from proceeding in Ainsley Street other than in a generally south bound direction, from its junction with Bethnal Green Road to its junction with Copperfield Street;
 - (iv) all vehicles from proceeding in Derbyshire Street other than in a generally south bound direction, from its junction with Bethnal Green Road to its junction with Hague Street.

TORRIDGE DISTRICT COUNCIL

PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ACT 1990 SECTION 70(8)
