The Gloucestershire County Council (Hempstead Bypass Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1997

The Gloucestershire County Council hereby give notice that they have made, and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under section 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 for authorising the Council:

- (a) to carry out improvements to Hempstead Lane (South) 3/8012, Hempstead Lane (North) 3/8012 and unnumbered road leading to Gloucester Civic Amenity Tip;
- (b) to stop up private means of access; and
- (c) to provide new means of access to premises.

All on or in the vicinity of the classified road known as A430 Hempstead Bypass (which forms part of Gloucester South West Bypass) which the Council are proposing to construct from a point on Hempstead Lane (south) 114 metres west of Hempstead Bridge northwards to a point on Hempstead Lane (north) 240 metres south of the junction with Spinnaker Road (classified road 3/8012).

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plans may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours from 7th July 1997 until 19th August 1997, at the offices of the Gloucestershire County Council, Main Reception, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, Gloucester City Council, North Warehouse, The Docks, Gloucester, Hempstead Post Office, Hempstead, Gloucester, and at the Main Reception, Department of Transport, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle upon Tyne.
