TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

HIGHWAYS AGENCY

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The M41 West Cross Route (Holland Park Roundabout to A40(M)/M41 Junction Trunk Road) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that roads he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads from the date when the Order comes into force:

- (a) a route ("the main route") about 195 metres in length, from the easternmost highway boundary of the existing M41 West Cross Route westwards to a proposed new roundabout on Ariel Way in the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham; and
